This event will be a Silver level (State Championships) event. The event will be conducted under the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations</u>.



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
Event Village

Location: The event village is located in the centre of the park on the mezzanine level. Access via the main gate, Leawood Gardens and unsealed road within the park.

Car Parking: Car parking will be available within the park near the event village. Signage will be in place.

Rider Transport: There will be no shuttle transport provided during the racing.

Registration: Event registrations will be onsite at the event village. Registrations will be open as outlined in the Event Schedule.

Postponement

In the case of the local emergency authority issuing a fire or weather warning which requires that the event location is to be evacuated, or SA Health imposing COVID restrictions preventing the event proceeding on the planned dates, then all event activities will be postponed to a date agreed by the event organisers.

Should such an issue arise, the Event Host will issue an advice at least one day prior to postponement.

The Event Host is responsible for communicating the situation to all agencies, including local authorities, the Chief Commissaire, participants and event crews.

Insurance

Both public liability and rider insurance will be provided by AusCycling's standard insurance policies. Current AusCycling Race licence is a minimum requirement for entry.



Registration

Participants are able to enter races in the event through EntryBoss.



Food & Beverages

A range of food and drinks will be available for sale from vendors.

Shelter

Clubs and teams will have a designated area to set up tents for their personal use.

Amenities

Toilets will be available at the village site as per local authority requirements.

Waste Management

Bins will be available around the event village and rubbish collection will be arranged.













Public Safety

COVID-19 Management

The event will be run under South Australian COVID safety guidelines as applicable at the time of the event. Recommendations detailed in the latest AMBC COVID Safe Plan will be implemented.

Incident Management

First Aid, Medical and Rescue Services will be provided or arranged by the appointed medical services provider.

Emergency information will be communicated via loudspeaker in the event village. Additional communication with marshals will occur around the course as required.

Evacuation routes are via the Main Gate and Emergency Access Gate outlined in the event location maps.

The designated contact during incident management is the Race Director.



Additional Information

First Aid/Medical Services

The first aid area is located within the main event village. The first aid area will be manned during competition. The first aid area will not be manned outside these times.

Water/ Hydration

Potable water will be made available in the event village.

Photographers

An official event photographer will be appointed by the host and various accredited photographers will be roaming throughout the event and venue. Details will be made available after the event.

Live streaming of the event is being investigated.

Race Timing

The event will be timed, recorded and published by AMBC with further display and publication by AusCycling.

All competitors will be issued with a race plate and timing transponder at Registration. The race plate is to be installed with the number visible at the front of the bike and the transponder installed low on the fork.

Anti-Doping Testing

All competitors may be subject to anti-doping testing. Should ASADA wish to attend the event an additional toilet and private area will be provided.
